The Linux Install Fest Event at the Phoenix Regional will assist any computer build participant with the installation of Linux on your new computer. However, the installation of Linux is the responsibility of the participant and is NOT part of the Computer Build Event.

The Build event is where you can build a new computer, with the computer specs detailed below. This computer build includes a Full Windows 7 Ultimate NOT trial, this is worth **\$319.99**: IF you are one of the first 20, who pay to participate in the computer build event and who have selected that they want Windows 7 on the computer that they are building; then you will be one of the lucky participants, who will receive a FREE copy of Windows 7..

A follow-up email will be sent to each participant to confirm the participant's choices and whether or not they will be getting a free copy of Windows 7, as part of their computer build event.

The computer is a 64 bit AMD processor with 2gigs of RAM, a 1 TB hard drive, a DVD-ROM that 48x CD-ROM & 16x DVD-ROM read speeds.

When finished, all machines will be just a white box with Windows 7 Ultimate operating system (for the first 20 paid attendees at the computer build) and anti-virus software.

The cost of the computer build class will be **\$510.00** but when this computer is built, it will have a value of **\$1,599** on the open market.

You will be building a top of the line Gamers' level fast machine with on board video, sound and NIC.

Here is what you will need to bring with you to the computer build class:

- Slot screw driver
- Phillips screw driver (it would probably be best to bring a case that has different sizes of screw drivers heads.

Please note that these prices are at a special discount and should not be compared to retail store prices.

If you want to make your new computer a true Gamers' Machine, then you will need to add the following:

- 4 GB of DDR2 RAM,
- Top of the line dual video cards with at least 612 of RAM for the video card and surround sound audio system.
